EXTENSION OF LAST DATE TO APPLY FOR SKILL COURSES FOR SESSION 2020-2021

This is with reference to Circular No. 25/2020 dated 07.04.2020 regarding 'Introduction of Skill courses from classes VI to XI from the session 2020-21' whereby it was informed that the last date for applying to introduce skill subjects for session 2020-2021 was 31st May 2020.

Taking in view the present situation, the Competent Authority of the Board has decided that the last date to apply for introducing skill subjects for session 2020-2021 should be extended up to <u>15th July 2020.</u>
